Chronic diseases — such as diabetes, HIV, hyperthyroidism, hypothyroidism, or a buildup of iron (hemochromatosis) or protein (amyloidosis) — also may contribute to heart failure. Causes of acute heart failure include viruses that attack the heart muscle, severe infections, allergic reactions, blood clots in the lungs, the use of certain medications or any illness that affects the whole body.

In the Acute Decompensated Heart Failure National Registry (ADHERE) database, BUN  $\geq 43$  mg/dl was the single best predictor, followed by systolic blood pressure  $< 115$  mmHg on admission and SCr  $\geq 2.75$  mg/dl (243.1  $\mu\text{mol/l}$ ), of in-hospital mortality among 65275 AHF admissions.
