In the early 20th Century, a huge emphasis was placed on Behaviourist approaches to explaining language acquisition which lead to large group studies involving systematic/controlled tests – The most influential behaviourist theory is that of Operant Conditioning proposed by Skinner (1950s) who generalised his thorough research on rats to explain how children acquire language.
